Admission Information

Application Instructions: Use the [program search](#) to explore degree options. View admission requirements (go.yorku.ca/requirements). Submit your application through OUAC (ouac.on.ca), or the York University application, by the deadline (futurestudents.yorku.ca/requirements/deadlines). Once you receive access to MyFile (yorku.ca/myfile) submit all required documents. Learn more at: yorku.ca/apply.

Processing Time: All decisions/application information can be found on applicant MyFile Accounts (yorku.ca/myfile) 4-6 weeks upon receipt of complete application information.

- **Dec – Jan:** based on top grade 11 and/or midterm grade 12 marks.
- **Feb-Mar:** based on top final grade 12 and/or grade 11 marks.
- **Apr-May:** based on top grade 12 final/midterm marks.
- **July:** Final admission status confirmed when official results are received

MyFile – York's Admissions Portal

Within a week of applying, students receive an email with their York University student number and a link to MyFile (yorku.ca/myfile), their admission portal where they can: check application status, accept offers, upload required documents*, apply for residence, book their enrollment appointments and more. Advise your students to check MyFile regularly.

*English language proficiency results must be sent directly to York University from the testing centre. If a student uploads an incorrect document, direct them to the MyDocServ (secure.students.yorku.ca/mydocserve) page to notify us.

Recommendations for Faster Processing

Student Transcripts Service (STS) for applicants from BC and Yukon. Enables students to electronically send their secondary school transcripts to post-secondary institutions. See the following [help videos](#) for more details: yorku.ca/go/bc-sts

Complete Transcripts: showing grades for completed/in progress courses AND future course enrollment(s) are required to confirm the applicant's intent to complete their provincial secondary school diploma.

Admissible Courses

York University accepts all Ministry-inspected and approved courses. Students/families should conduct due diligence prior to registering for courses at a private school to ensure it is approved by the Ministry of Education.

Inadmissible Courses

Physical Education, Technical Skills, Applied, Vocational and Board Authority, and non-academic level courses are generally not accepted.

Grade 11 Marks for Early Considered

Most programs use Grade 11 marks for early consideration which are conditional on Grade 12 final marks, including prerequisites and completion of the respective Provincial Secondary School Diploma.

Transfer Credit

Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB) & other Advanced Standing Assessments may provide up to 30 transfer credits, depending on the program. Learn more at: futurestudents.yorku.ca/advanced-secondary-cegep

Special Consideration

Students may complete a form to explain any [extenuating circumstances](#) that may have affected their academic performance. On a case-by-case basis, students who do not meet admission requirements but demonstrate a strong academic record/commitment to improvement, may have their application reviewed by an admissions sub-committee for a holistic evaluation futurestudents.yorku.ca/requirements/extenuating-circumstances

Alternative Offers of Admission

Students who are not admitted to the program they applied to may be admissible to a related program and will be provided an alternative offer of admission.

Deferral Requests

Most programs will consider a deferral request for up to 1 year, **excluding BBA/iBBA, Nursing, and Social Work** programs. To defer, students must first accept their offer, and then complete York's deferral request form by the deadline at: yorku.ca/go/defer-admission

Admission Requirements

Offers are based on top grade 11/12 academic/university courses including prerequisites. [Program requirements](#) differ based on province and program.

Quebec CEGEP

- One year of CEGEP
- 2 semesters of English (code 603) / Français (code 601); **and** 10 additional academic courses
- Min. 70% OVGPA req. for transfer credit eligibility. Max. 30 credits (5 full year courses) may be awarded for completion of the DEC.

IB Diploma

Passes in **six** subjects: 3 at SL and 3 at HL **OR** 2 at SL and 4 at HL

Req. for Initial Review

- High School Transcript(s)
- IB Predicted Grades

For most programs, min. scores of 30+ recommended (scores of 28 considered)

AP – Transfer Credits: Students with completed AP courses with grades of 4 or 5 may receive up to 30 credits of transfer credit.

***Alberta ONLY** 5 credit grade 12 academic courses numbered 30-1 and 31 meet York U admission requirements – **with the exception of Math 30-2**. All other “30-2” courses (eg. Social Studies 30-2), are generally inadmissible.

Programs Requiring Supplemental Applications (Supp. App)

- **School of the Arts, Media, Performance & Design:** Cinema & Media Arts – Production, Screenwriting; Dance, Design; Music, Theatre, Visual Arts – Studio. Evaluation, audition, or portfolio. For a list of programs requiring a supplementary application, visit ampd.yorku.ca/apply
- **Education (B.Ed Concurrent):** Supplementary Information Form (SIF) - experience summary, experience profile, personal statement, and 2 reference letters.
- **Glendon International Studies and Business Administration** dual credential program: A bilingual digital portfolio and interview.
- **Schulich School of Business (BBA, iBBA):** Supplementary application.

English Proficiency Requirements

- Students who attend 4 years at an accredited high school where the institution’s official language is English may meet requirements. IELTS, TOEFL, Duolingo, & Cambridge English Language Assessment accepted. Visit: futurestudents.yorku.ca/requirements/language-tests
- Test centres must send IELTS or TOEFL results electronically (York U #0894). Allow up to three weeks processing time.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

Bursaries

Students must complete a Student Financial Profile (sfs.yorku.ca/aid/sfp) to apply for supports such as scholarships, awards, bursaries and on-campus employment. **New:** Expanded bursaries to support financial need. An additional \$150,000 is planned to support continuing students in financial need.

Guaranteed Auto Entrance Scholarships

Faculty of Science Entrance Scholarship - \$2,000: awarded to applicants admitted to the Faculty of Science having an average of 90%+

Lassonde Entrance Scholarship - \$2,000: awarded to applicants admitted to the Lassonde School of Engineering having an average of 90%+

Renewable Automatic Entrance Scholarships

- 95%+ (42-45 IB diploma points) – \$4,000
- 90-94.9% (36-41 IB diploma points) – \$2,500
- 85-89.9% (33-35 IB diploma points) – \$1,500
- 80-84.9% (30-32 IB diploma points) – \$1,000
- **Plus \$1,500 Study Abroad Award** - for students with admission average 80%+ if they participate in a formal exchange experience
- York Automatic Entrance Scholarships are automatically applied, renewable at all levels for up to four years and can be regained when you recover the minimum required GPA.

Additional Scholarships

The Tentanda Via Award: Awarded to resilient students who have overcome barriers in the pursuit of a university education, or who are leaders with proven commitment to making a difference.

Schulich School of Business, SRPAA Leadership Award for Black and Indigenous Communities: valued at \$7,500 each and are renewable for the next three years. The maximum amount per student is \$30,000. Apply at: schulich.yorku.ca/srpaa-awards.

Scholarship Application Deadline: Typically, deadlines are February 15 (for international students) or April 1 (for domestic students). Deadlines may vary. Learn more at: futurestudents.yorku.ca/funding.

Residence Information

Application Fee + Deposit: Students apply to residence through MyFile and pay \$150 application fee (\$50 non-refundable admin. fee). Upon moving in, \$100 credit will be applied to the student’s York account. A \$500 non-refundable room deposit to secure residence reservation is due in June 2023.

Apply Early: First-year students admitted to the fall session directly from high school and who applied by the deadline (June 1, 2023) are guaranteed a space in residence. Students admitted with a 90%+ average are guaranteed a single room if requested. We advise students to apply by May 1 for early consideration.

Residence Options

- **On-Campus:** Ten undergraduate residences are available on campus. All buildings are co-ed, though same-gender floors and washrooms are available. Learn more at: yorku.ca/housing.
