## How to Calculate GPA

| Percentage | Letter Grade | GPA |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| $95-100$ | A+ | 4.0 |
| $90-94$ | A | 4.0 |
| $86-89$ | A- | 3.7 |
| $82-85$ | B+ | 3.3 |
| $78-81$ | B | 3.0 |
| $73-77$ | B- | 2.7 |
| $67-72$ | C+ | 2.3 |
| $60-66$ | C | 2.0 |
| $50-59$ | C- | 1.7 |
| $0-49$ | F/I | $0-1.3$ |

Steps:

1. Determine the GPA for each 4 credit course you have taken
2. Add up all the GPA
3. Divide the total by the total number of courses you have taken

You can use this GPA Calculator but you also need to include the course credits. The majority of our courses in the Surrey School District from grades 10-12 are 4 credits each.

English Language Arts:
There are some exceptions though with English 10 Composition being worth 2 and then English 10 Creative Writing, Literary Studies, and New Media being worth 2. You should have a total of 4 grade 10 English Language Arts Credits.

Most schools will ask for a GPA for your senior or grade 11 and 12 courses. Some might ask for all grade 10-12 courses.
