Week 1, will be held during Spring Break and Week 2 will be held the beginning of July. After successfully completing your second week, you will receive the required tools and be placed on a jobsite. Starting rate after finishing this class is \$29.27/hour plus vacation pay and benefits. After 6 months on the job the union will sponsor you in an apprenticeship.
