

- Open for grade 10 and 11 students to apply



Labour Market Outlook 2023

Over the next decade, 5 industries will generate ~55% of the job openings in BC.

- 1. Health care / social assistance 166,300 or 17%
- 2. Professional, scientific and technical services 142,400 or 14%
- 3. Retail trade 103,700 or 10%
- 4. Education services 70,500 or 7%
- 5. Construction trades 66,600 or 7%

Construction Craft Worker

- LiUNA Training Plus
- 4 week program, starts the end of June
- Candidates need to have all graduation requirements completed prior to program start
- Good hand-eye coordination
- Physically fit / manual labour
- Capable of lifting 22kg / 50 lbs
- Working indoors / outdoors
- Able to transition into full-time employment / apprenticeship following the program







IN TRADES

Youth WORK in Trades

- Do you already have a job in the trades?
- You can earn up to 4 courses worth of credits! (16 credits total!)
 - Must register with the ITA as an apprentice
 - Must have a sponsor who is a red seal certified
 - Accumulate hours towards your apprenticeship
 - (120 hours per course credit)
 - Get paid minimum wage
 - Parental agreement
- Scholarships available for students who work 900 hours before they turn 19
- If this is you, come to the Career Centre and speak to Ms. Duffield



Non-Trades Programs

Full Semester

Drafting/CADD (Computer Aided Design & Drafting)

- KPU Cloverdale Campus
 - (4 courses)
- Year long, 2 nights a week
- Prerequisites
 - Completion of grade 10 with a C+ or better in Math 10
 - Have taken or are enrolled in Drafting/CADD 11 and/or 12











Early Childhood Education

- Douglas College
- 2nd semester
- 10-week theory prior to 200-hour practicum experience
- Must be in grade 12 and an early grad (completed all grad requirements end of 1st semester)
- Excellent attendance / punctuality / maturity
- Strong speaking / listening skills
- Desire to work with small children
- Upon successful completion of the program, you will receive an Early Childhood Educator Assistant License
- Ladders into Diploma program at Douglas

Nursing Prep

- KPU Surrey Campus, 2nd Semester
- Pre-requisites
 - English 12, minimum C+
 - Chemistry 11, minimum B
 - Anatomy & Physiology 12, minimum B
- Excellent attendance & punctuality
- Strong speaking and listening skills
- Students receive 4 dual credit courses
 - Psych 1100 Biology 1160
 - English 1100 Biology 1260
- Transfers into KPU BSc and other institutes

Tah-tul-ut Indigenous Education Pathway

- SFU Surrey Campus and Surrey Community College
- Semester 1: one evening a week
- Semester 2: full time program
- Prerequisites
 - Complete high school graduation requirements by the end of first semester of grade 12
 - C+ or better in English 12; excellent written communication skills
 - Strong math skills recommended Foundations of Pre-Calculus
 - Identify as an Indigenous person
- Earn an Education Assistant Diploma from Surrey Community College
- At the end of the program, students can choose to go on to work as an EA or to continue their studies in the Bachelor of General Studies in Education program at SFU (pathway to teaching)

- For students interested in pursuing careers in law enforcement



- In partnership with Emily Carr University of Art + Design
- Takes place at Guildford Park Secondary
- Sept-Dec, Wed nights
- Prerequisites
 - C or better in English 11 or 12
 - Have taken or be enrolled in two grade 11 or 12 academic courses and two electives
 - Art 11 or 12 recommended
- This program is NOT paid by Surrey Schools, but it allows you to skip the portfolio in the application to Emily Carr


