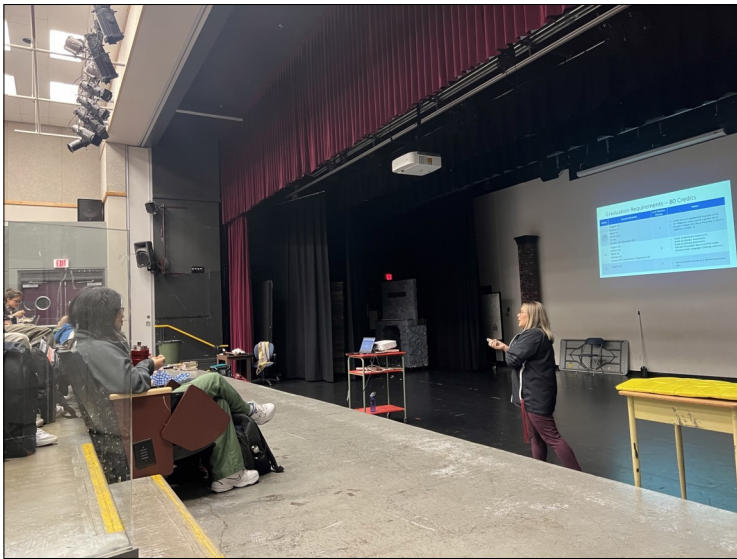

Each school can nominate one student for the University of Toronto National Book Award. This award holds no monetary value, rather, it is to recognize the top student in our school who excels in academic pursuits, demonstrates enthusiasm for intellectual exploration and has a strong involvement in the lives of their schools and communities. While the National Book Award does not need to go to a student who is applying to the University of Toronto, preference may be given to one who is.

Why should you apply if it holds no monetary value? Being recognized for this award looks really good on post-secondary and other scholarship applications. It may also give you a leg up when applying for the University of Toronto National Scholarship Program.

The student who is selected as the National Book Award recipient, **as well as all other students** who are planning to attend the University of Toronto are welcome to apply to the National Scholarship Program at U of T. This is a full-ride scholarship for up to 4 years.

If you meet the following criteria, you are welcome and encouraged to complete this nomination form:

- Demonstrates superior academic performance
- Demonstrates original and creative thought
- Demonstrates exceptional extra-curricular achievement in a broad context
- Must be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or protected person



Deadline to apply to this nomination form: October 5, 2023, midnight.

Deadline to apply to the University of Toronto National Scholarship: October 19, 2023.

This is a **NOMINATION** scholarship. Students apply to the Kwantlen Park Career Centre and the Kwantlen Park Scholarship Committee will determine our nominee to put forward for this Scholarship.

The deadline to apply for nomination is December 22, 2023. The student nominated will then have a few weeks to complete the application process and submit their application to Schulich by the deadline January 30, 2024.

Ms. Duffield highly recommends that students read up on the former students who have received scholarships. This is a highly competitive scholarship so it's important to do your research and put forward a well-written, strong application.
